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Republicans looking strong in Alaska

Raleigh, N.C. – For now it doesn't look like Republicans will have much trouble holding onto their Senate and House seats in Alaska this year.

Lisa Murkowski's approval rating is 52%, with 36% of voters in the state disapproving of her. Those are pretty solid numbers in a time when Congress as a whole is quite unpopular. Tested against a generic Democratic opponent Murkowski leads by a dominant 52-25 margin.

Most voters in her party are happy with Murkowski and she also has a 33% approval rating with Democrats, more crossover support than most of her peers benefit from. In a finding that helps sum up the current political climate independent voters actually disapprove of her by a 44/43 margin but she leads 42-27 on the generic ballot with them anyway.

Don Young can't match Murkowski's standing but he looks ok for reelection as well. His approval rating is 43% with 41% of voters expressing unhappiness with his job performance. He has very little support from Democrats at 17%, but continues to have a strong standing within his own party.


Young leads Harry Crawford 49-34, winning 16% of the Democratic vote while Crawford gets just 9% of the GOP vote. Young also leads 41-38 with independents.

"Democrats aren't going to be knocking off many Congressional incumbents in 2010," said Dean Debnam, President of Public Policy Polling. "They certainly aren't going to be beating many in Republican states like Alaska."

PPP surveyed 710 Alaska voters on January 27th and 28th. The margin of error is +/-3.7%. Other factors, such as refusal to be interviewed and weighting, may introduce additional error that is more difficult to quantify.
